2	AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO TAKE SEA OATS IN CARTERET AND		
3	PENDER COUNTIES.		
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
5	SECTION 1. Article 22 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by		
6	adding a new section to read:		
7	7 "§ 14-129.2. Unlawful to take sea oats in Carteret and Pender Counties.		
8	(a) It is unlawful to dig up, pull up, or take from the land of another or from any		
9	9 public domain, the whole or any part of any Sea Oats (Uniola paniculata).		
10	(b) Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this section shall be		
11	guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten		
12	dollars (\$10.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each offense.		
13	(c) <u>The provisions of this section apply only to Carteret and Pender Counties.</u> "		
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to		
15	offenses committed on or after that date.
