A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO TAKE SEA OATS.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 14-129 reads as rewritten:

5 "§ 14-129. Taking, etc., of certain wild plants from land of another.

No person, firm or corporation shall dig up, pull up or take from the land of another 6 or from any public domain, the whole or any part of any Venus flytrap (Dionaea 7 8 muscipula), trailing arbutus, Aaron's Rod (Thermopsis caroliniana), Bird-foot Violet 9 (Viola pedata), Bloodroot (Sanguinaria canadensis), Blue Dogbane (Amsonia 10 tabernaemontana), Cardinal-flower (Lobelia cardinalis), Columbine (Aquilegia 11 canadensis), Dutchman's Breeches (Dicentra cucullaria), Maidenhair Fern (Adiantum 12 pedatum), Walking Fern (Camptosorus rhizophyllus), Gentians (Gentiana), Ginseng (Panax quinquefolium), Ground Cedar, Running Cedar, Hepatica (Hepatica americana 13 14 and acutiloba), Jack-in-the-Pulpit (Arisaema triphyllum), Lily (Lilium), Lupine Monkshood (Aconitum uncinatum and reclinatum), 15 (Lupinus), May Apple (Podophyllum peltatum), Orchids (all species), Pitcher Plant (Sarracenia), Sea Oats 16 17 (Uniola paniculata), Shooting Star (Dodecatheon meadia), Oconee Bells (Shortia galacifolia), Solomon's Seal (Polygonatum), Trailing Christmas (Greens-Lycopodium), 18 Trillium (Trillium), Virginia Bluebells (Mertensia virginica), and Fringe Tree 19 (Chionanthus virginicus), American holly, white pine, red cedar, hemlock or other 20 coniferous trees, or any flowering dogwood, any mountain laurel, any rhododendron, or 21 any ground pine, or any Christmas greens, or any Judas tree, or any leucothea, or any 22 23 azalea, without having in his possession a permit to dig up, pull up or take such plants, 24 signed by the owner of such land, or by his duly authorized agent. Any person convicted 25 of violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor only punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than fifty dollars 26 27 (\$50.00) for each offense. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the Counties 28 of Cabarrus, Carteret, Catawba, Cherokee, Chowan, Cumberland, Currituck, Dare,

- 3 SECTION 2. Article 22 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by
 4 adding a new section to read:
- 5 "<u>§ 14-129.2. Unlawful to take sea oats.</u>

6 (a) It is unlawful to dig up, pull up, or take from the land of another or from any

public domain the whole or any part of any Sea Oats (Uniola paniculata) without the
consent of the owner of that land.

9 (b) Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this section shall be

10 guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-

- 11 five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each offense."
- 12 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to 13 offenses committed on or after that date.
