5	SECT	<b>FION 1.</b> Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by

8	An insurer shall provide every prospective applicant and prospective enrollee with a		
9	clear and concise description of the coverage provided by the insurer's health benefit		
10	plan. The description shall be printed on a form prescribed by the Commissioner. The		
11	1 <u>description shall specify:</u>		
12	<u>(1)</u>	Definitions of terms used in the health benefit plan.	
13	<u>(2)</u>	A brief description of the principal benefits and coverage provided,	
14		including any coverage exclusions or limitations.	
15	<u>(3)</u>	A brief description of how coverage determinations are made,	
16		including whether factors other than medical necessity and coverage	
17		exclusions and limitations are considered.	
18	<u>(4)</u>	A brief explanation of insurer and insured payment responsibilities,	
19		including how plan allowances, such as 'usual and customary charges',	
20		are developed.	
21	<u>(5)</u>	A brief explanation of provider network limitations and requirements,	
22		including requirements for the use of sub-networks, prior authorization	
23		or precertification, and the arrangements of tertiary and quaternary	
24		<u>care.</u>	
25	<u>(6)</u>	Tax and health plan accreditation status of the insurer.	
26	<u>(7)</u>	A statement that the outline is a summary of the health benefit plan	
27		and that the health benefit plan should be examined to determine	
28		specific health benefit plan provisions."

- 2 all health benefit plans that are delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after
- 3 January 1, 2003.
