9	9 SECTION 1. G.S. 120-70.94 reads as rewritten:		
10	"§ 120-70.94. Purpose and powers of Committee.		
11	(a) The Joint Legislative Corrections and Crime Control Corrections, Crime		
12	Control, and Juvenile Justice Oversight Committee shall examine, on a continuing basis,		
13	the correctional and law enforcement correctional, law enforcement, and juvenile justice		
14	systems in North Carolina, in order to make ongoing recommendations to the General		
15			
16	to assist those systems in realizing their objectives of protecting the public and of		
17	punishing and rehabilitating offenders. In this examination, the Committee shall:		
18	(1) Study the budget, programs, and policies of the Departments of		
19	Correction and Crime Control and Public Satfey, Correction, Crime		
20	Control and Public Safety, and Juvenile Justice and Delinquency		
21	<u>Prevention</u> to determine ways in which the General Assembly may		
22	improve the effectiveness of those Departments;		
23	(2) Examine the effectiveness of the Department of Correction in		
24	implementing the public policy stated in G.S. 148-26 of providing		
25	work assignments and employment for inmates as a means of reducing		
26	the cost of maintaining the inmate population while enabling inmates		
27	to acquire or retain skills and work habits needed to secure honest		
28	employment after their release;		

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1	(2a) E	xamine the effectiveness of the Department of Crime Control and	
2	P	ublic Safety in implementing the duties and responsibilities charged	
3	to	the Department in G.S. 143B-474 and the overall effectiveness and	
4	ef	ficiency of law enforcement in the State; and	
5	<u>(2b)</u> <u>E</u>	xamine the effectiveness of the Department of Juvenile Justice and	
6	D	elinquency Prevention in implementing the duties and	
7	re	sponsibilities charged to the Department in Article 12 of Chapter	
8	14	43B of the General Statutes and the overall effectiveness and	
9	ef	ficiency of the juvenile justice system in the State; and	
10	(3) St	tudy any other matters that the Committee considers necessary.	
11	(b) The Cou	mmittee may make interim reports to the General Assembly on	
12	2 matters for which it may report to a regular session of the General Assembly. A report		
13	to the General A	Assembly may contain any legislation needed to implement a	
14	recommendation of	f the Committee."	
15	SECTIO	ON 2. Except for the section of the General Statutes amended in this	
16	act, the Revisor o	f Statutes shall substitute the term "Joint Legislative Corrections,	
17	Crime Control, a	nd Juvenile Justice Oversight Committee" for the term "Joint	
18	Legislative Corrections and Crime Control Oversight Committee" everywhere that term		
19	appears in the General Statutes.
