1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE 2002  
2 EXTRA SESSION OF THE NORTH CAROLINA HOUSE OF  
3 REPRESENTATIVES.

4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

5 **SECTION 1.** The permanent rules of the 2001 Regular Session of the House  
6 of Representatives, with the following amendments, are adopted as the permanent rules  
7 of the 2002 Extra Session:

8 (1) Rule 1 shall read as follows: "**RULE 1. Convening Hour.** The House  
9 shall convene each legislative day at the hour fixed by the House. In  
10 the event the House adjourns on the preceding legislative day without  
11 having fixed an hour for reconvening, the House shall convene on the  
12 next legislative day at 10:00 A.M."

13 (2) Notwithstanding Rule 26, the Committee on Rules, Calendar, and  
14 Operations of the House and the Ethics Committee shall be comprised  
15 of the members who were appointed during the regular session and  
16 such other members as the Speaker may appoint at the beginning of  
17 the Extra Session. The Chairs and Vice-chairs of those committees  
18 shall be those who were appointed by the Speaker during the Regular  
19 Session.

20 (3) Notwithstanding Rule 27, the standing committees and permanent  
21 subcommittees of the House are:

26 All rules of the 2001 Regular Session applicable to standing  
27 committees and permanent subcommittees of the House other than the

- 1 committees named in this subdivision are inoperative. The Speaker  
2 may appoint select committees under Rule 26.
- 3 (4) Notwithstanding Rule 31(a), all bills and resolutions shall be  
4 introduced by submitting same to the Principal Clerk's Office.
- 5 (5) Notwithstanding Rules 31 and 31.1:  
6 a. The only resolutions that may be introduced or considered in  
7 the House are resolutions adjourning the Extra Session sine die.  
8 b. All bills shall be excluded from introduction or consideration in  
9 the House, other than bills adopting new redistricting plans for  
10 the North Carolina House of Representatives and the North  
11 Carolina Senate, and legislation providing in 2002 only for  
12 scheduling of the primaries and necessary amendments to  
13 scheduling for the general election.
- 14 (6) Notwithstanding Rule 31.1, all bills or resolutions must be introduced  
15 not later than 3:00 P.M. on Wednesday, May 15, 2002.
- 16 (7) Notwithstanding Rule 32, a resolution adjourning the Extra Session  
17 sine die may be placed on the calendar without being referred by the  
18 Speaker to a committee.
- 19 (8) Notwithstanding Rule 41:  
20 a. The first reading and reference to a standing committee of a  
21 House bill shall occur on the legislative day of its introduction.  
22 The first reading and reference to a standing committee of a  
23 Senate bill shall occur on the legislative day of its receipt on  
24 messages from the Senate. The Speaker shall give notice at each  
25 subsequent reading whether it is the second or third reading.  
26 b. Except for a bill governed by Article II, Section 23 of the North  
27 Carolina Constitution, a bill may be read more than once on the  
28 same day.
- 29 (9) Notwithstanding Rule 44(d), a conference report may be placed on the  
30 calendar for the legislative day on which the report is received.
- 31 (10) Notwithstanding Rule 59, any member wishing to cosponsor a bill or  
32 resolution which has been introduced may do so by appearing in the  
33 office of the Principal Clerk for such purpose on the day during which  
34 such bill or resolution was first read and referred, but only while the  
35 bill or resolution is in the possession of the House.

36 **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
