"(a) In order to carry out the purposes of this Article, the Commissional Director, or their duly authorized agents, upon presenting appropriate credentials to owner, operator, or agent in charge, are authorized:  (1) To enter without delay, and at any reasonable time, any factory, prestablishment, construction site, or other area, work place environment where work is being performed by an employee of employer; and	o the plant, e or
(2) To inspect and investigate during regular working hours, and at reasonable times, and within reasonable limits, and in a reason manner, any such place of employment and all pertinent condit processes, structures, machines, apparatus, devices, equipment, materials therein, and to question privately any such employer, or operator, agent or employee.	nable tions, and
(3) The Commissioner or Director, or their duly authorized agents, reinspect any place of employment where a willful serious viol was found to exist during the previous inspection and a final Orde been entered."	ation er has
