| 9 | 1 through January 1 of each year." |
| 10 | SECTION 2. Section 6 of Chapter 208 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as |
| 11 | rewritten: |
| 12 | "Sec. 6. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season for |
| 13 | taking foxes by trapping in Brunswick County Brunswick County, Columbus County, |
| 14 | and Pitt County from January 2 through January 31 of each year. During this season, all |
| 15 | leghold traps set on dry land with solid anchor shall have at least three swivels in the |
| 16 | trap chain and no leghold traps larger than size one and one-half may be used." |
| 17 | SECTION 3. Section 9 of Chapter 208 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as |
| 18 | rewritten: |
| 19 | "Sec. 9. Sections 1 through 3 of this act apply only to Granville and Franklin |
| 20 | Counties. Sections 4 through 8 of this act apply only to Brunswick County. and |

Columbus Counties."

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective October 1, 2004.
