A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE A FOUR-YEAR TERM FOR THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN  
2 OF CHADBOURN.  
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4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 2.3 of the Charter of the Town of Chadbourn, being  
6 Chapter 895, Session Laws of 1989, reads as rewritten:

7 "Sec. 2.3. Mayor; Term of Office; Duties. ~~The~~In 2003 and quadrennially thereafter,  
8 the Mayor shall be elected by all the qualified voters of the Town for a term of ~~two~~ four  
9 years or until his or her successor is elected and qualified; shall be the official head of  
10 the Town government and preside at meetings of the Council; shall have the right to  
11 vote only when there is an equal division on any question or matter before the Council;  
12 and shall exercise the powers and duties conferred by law or as directed by the  
13 Council."

14 **SECTION 2.** Section 3.3 of the Charter of the Town of Chadbourn, being  
15 Chapter 895, Session Laws of 1989, reads as rewritten:

16 "Sec. 3.3. Election of Mayor. A Mayor shall be elected in ~~each~~ a regular municipal  
17 election."

18 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective beginning with the Mayor elected in the  
19 2003 municipal election.
