1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO THE LAW CLARIFYING
3	THE STATUS OF TEACHERS PARTICIPATING IN FOREIGN EXCHANGE
4	PROGRAMS FOR PURPOSES OF RETIREMENT AND TENURE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 135-1(25) reads as rewritten:
7	"(25) "Teacher" shall mean any teacher, helping teacher, classroom teacher
8	in a job-sharing position as defined in G.S. 115C-302.2(b) except for a
9	beneficiary in that position, librarian, principal, supervisor,
10	superintendent of public schools or any full-time employee, city or
11	county, superintendent of public instruction, or any full-time employee
12	of Department of Public Instruction, president, dean or teacher, or any
13	full-time employee in any educational institution supported by and
14	under the control of the State: Provided, that the term "teacher" shall
15	not include any part-time, temporary, or substitute teacher or employee
16	except for a classroom teacher in a job-sharing position, and shall not
17	include those participating in an optional retirement program provided
18	for in G.S. 135-5.1 or G.S. 135-5.4. In all cases of doubt, the Board of
19	Trustees, hereinbefore defined, shall determine whether any person is a
20	teacher as defined in this Chapter. On and after August 1, 2001, a
21	person who is a nonimmigrant alien and who otherwise meets the
22	requirements of this subdivision shall not be excluded from the
23	definition of "teacher" solely because the person holds a temporary or
24	time-limited visa. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the term "teacher"
25	shall not include any nonimmigrant alien employed in elementary or
26	secondary public schools (whether employed in a full-time, part-time,
27	temporary, permanent, or substitute teacher position) and participating
28	in an exchange visitor program designated by the United States

7	Department of State pursuant to 22 C.F.R. Part 62. 62 or by the United
8	States Department of Homeland Security pursuant to 8 C.F.R. Part
9	<u>214.2(q).</u> "
10	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
