A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LAKE ROYALE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO
2 ENFORCE THE LAW ON THE WATERS OF LAKE ROYALE AND TO
3 COMPETE FOR GRANTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT
4 EQUIPMENT.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.(a)** In addition to the powers granted to it by G.S. 74E-6(c), the
8 Lake Royale Police Department has the powers granted by that subsection on all of the
9 waters of Lake Royale and its shoreline area.

10 **SECTION 1.(b)** In performing duties relating to the enforcement of the
11 laws on the waters of Lake Royale or in its shoreline area, an officer of the Lake Royale
12 Police Department shall have such extraterritorial jurisdiction as may be necessary to
13 perform the officer's duties. These duties include investigations of crimes an officer
14 reasonably believes have been, or are about to be, committed within the area in
15 question, and include:

- 16 (1) Traversing by reasonable routes from one portion of this area to
17 another, including across territory not within the boundaries of the
18 waters of Lake Royale and its shoreline area;
- 19 (2) Conducting prisoners in custody to a court or to detention facilities as
20 may be authorized by law, although this may involve going outside the
21 area in question; and
- 22 (3) Continuing pursuit of and arresting any violator or suspected violator
23 when the grounds for arrest arose within the area in question, except
24 that this pursuit may not be conducted by virtue of this act beyond the
25 boundaries of Franklin and Nash Counties.

1 **SECTION 2.** The Lake Royale Police Department may participate in the
2 process for the awarding of any grants for the purchase of law enforcement equipment
3 for which the Department is eligible under the rules of the grant.

4 **SECTION 3.** In consideration of the public service provided, a company
5 police agency that is certified pursuant to Chapter 74E of the General Statutes and that
6 has been given expanded jurisdiction and authority spanning at least two counties, may
7 purchase gas, oil, and tires for their official vehicles and any other materials and
8 supplies under State contract through the Department of Administration, and may
9 purchase surplus property through the Department of Administration on the same basis
10 as counties and municipalities.

11 The Department of Administration shall make its services available to a
12 company police agency meeting the above qualifications in the purchase of such
13 supplies as provided in G.S. 143-49(6) and any rules adopted pursuant to that section.

14 **SECTION 4.** This act applies only to the Lake Royale Police Department
15 serving the Lake Royale community in Franklin and Nash Counties.

16 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
