A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS AND  
THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION TO STUDY METHODS OF  
REDUCING THE NUMBER OF UNCLAIMED RESTITUTION PAYMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** The Administrative Office of the Courts and the Department of Correction shall jointly study the processes for the collection and payment of restitution in this State, and shall determine methods for reducing the number of restitution payments that go unclaimed. The Administrative Office of the Courts and the Department of Correction shall report their findings and recommendations to the 2004 Regular Session of the 2003 General Assembly.

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
