The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Section 3.3(a) of the Charter of the Town of Mad	lison, being
Chapter 289 of the 1973 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:	
"(a) The members of the Board of Aldermen shall serve for terms of	of <del>two</del> - <u>four</u>
years, and the Mayor shall also-serve for a term of two years, beginning t	the day and
hour of the organizational meeting following their election, as established by	y ordinance
in accordance with this Charter; provided, they shall serve until their suc	ecessors are
elected and qualify. In the 2005 municipal election, six members shall be e	elected. The
three persons receiving the highest numbers of votes shall receive four-year	terms, and
the three persons receiving the next highest numbers of votes shall receiv	ve two-year
terms. In 2007 and biennially thereafter, three members shall be elected for	or four-year
terms."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective beginning with the 2005	5 municipal

election and does not affect the term of office of any current members.
