

1 (5) Two members appointed by the General Assembly upon the
2 recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate in
3 accordance with ~~G.S. 120-121~~; G.S. 120-121.

4 (6) Two members appointed by the General Assembly upon the
5 recommendation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives in
6 accordance with ~~G.S. 120-121~~; and G.S. 120-121.

7 (7) Two members appointed by the Governor."

8 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 116-233(d) reads as rewritten:

9 "(d) Members appointed under subdivisions (1) or (2) of subsection (a) of this
10 section shall serve staggered four-year terms. ~~terms expiring June 30 of odd numbered~~
11 years. ~~Eight of those terms shall expire June 30, 1993, and quadrennially thereafter, and~~
12 ~~eight of those terms shall expire June 30, 1995, and quadrennially thereafter.~~

13 (d1) Only an ex officio member shall be eligible to serve more than two
14 successive terms.

15 (d2) Any vacancy in the membership of the Board of Trustees appointed under
16 G.S. 116-233(a)(1) or (2) shall be reported promptly by the Secretary of the Board of
17 Trustees to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina, which shall fill
18 any such vacancy by appointment of a replacement member to serve for the balance of
19 the unexpired term. Any vacancy in members appointed under G.S. 116-233(a)(5) or (6)
20 shall be filled in accordance with G.S. 120-122. Any vacancy in members appointed
21 under G.S. 116-233(a)(7) shall be filled by the Governor for the remainder of the
22 unexpired term. Reapportionment of congressional districts does not affect the right of
23 any member to complete the term for which the member was appointed."

24 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2003. In order to maintain
25 the current schedule of staggered terms for members appointed under G.S.
26 116-233(a)(1) and (2), members currently serving shall continue to serve the terms to
27 which they were appointed, and the member appointed to the position created by this act
28 shall be appointed to a term to end June 30, 2007.
