2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR STAGGERED FOUR-YEAR TERMS FOR ALL FIVE
3	MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WILKES COUNTY,
4	RATHER THAN THE CURRENT SYSTEM WHERE FOUR OF THE MEMBERS
5	ARE ELECTED FOR STAGGERED FOUR-YEAR TERMS AND ONE FOR A
6	TWO-YEAR TERM.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	SECTION 1. In 2004 and quadrennially thereafter, three members of the
9	Board of Commissioners of Wilkes County shall be elected for four-year terms. In 2006
10	and quadrennially thereafter, two members of the Board of Commissioners of Wilkes
11	County shall be elected for four-year terms.
12	SECTION 2. Chapter 101 of the 1961 Session Laws and Chapter 217 of the
13	1963 Session Laws are repealed.
14	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and does not affect
15	the term of any current member.
