

1 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
 2 read:

3 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration
 4 plates:

5 ...
 6 (44c) Stock Car Racing Theme. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
 7 vehicle pursuant to G.S. 20-81.12. This is a series of plates bearing an
 8 emblem, seal, other symbol or design displaying themes of
 9 professional stock car auto racing, or professional stock car auto racing
 10 drivers. The Division shall not develop any plate in the series without a
 11 license to use copyrighted or registered words, symbols, trademarks, or
 12 designs associated with the plate. The plate shall be designed in
 13 consultation with and approved by the person authorized to provide the
 14 State with the license to use the words, symbols, trademarks, or
 15 designs associated with the plate. The Division shall not pay a royalty
 16 for the license to use the copyrighted or registered words, symbols,
 17 trademarks, or designs associated with the plate."

18 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

19 "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one
 20 registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled
 21 veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including
 22 additional Congressional Medal of Honor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of
 23 War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or
 24 G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

SECTION 4. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

35 **SECTION 5.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

36 "(b31) Stock Car Racing Theme. – The Division may issue any plate in this series
37 without a minimum number of applications if the person providing the State with the
38 license to use the words, logos, trademarks, or designs associated with the plate
39 produces the plate for the State without a minimum order quantity.

40 The cost of the Stock Car Racing Theme plate shall include all costs to produce
41 blank plates for issuance by the Division. Notwithstanding G.S. 66-58(b), the Division
42 or the Department of Correction may contract for the production of the blank plates in
43 this series to be issued by the Division, provided the plates meet or exceed the State's
44 specifications including durability and retroreflectivity, and provided the plates are

1 manufactured using high-quality embossable aluminum. The cost of the blank plates to
2 the State shall be substantially equivalent to the price paid to the Department of
3 Correction for license tags, as provided in G.S. 66-58(b)(15).

4 The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural
5 Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Stock Car Racing Theme plates to the
6 North Carolina Motor Sports Foundation, Inc."

7 **SECTION 6.** G.S. 20-85(a) reads as rewritten:

8 "(a) The following fees are imposed concerning a certificate of title, a registration
9 card, or a registration plate for a motor vehicle. These fees are payable to the Division
10 and are in addition to the tax imposed by Article 5A of Chapter 105 of the General
11 Statutes.

- 13 (2) Each application for duplicate or
14 corrected certificate of title..... 10.00
- 15 (3) Each application of reposessor for
16 certificate of title 10.00

27 motor vehicle transferred to a manufacturer,
28 as defined in G.S. 20-286, or a motor vehicle
29 retailer for the purpose of resale..... 10.00
- 30 (10) Each application for a salvage certificate of title
31 made by an insurer ~~10.00~~10.00
- 32 (11) Each set of replacement Stock Car Racing
33 Theme plates issued under G.S. 20-79.4 25.00."

34 **SECTION 7.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2004.
