SENATE BILL 778

Short Title: Funds for Adolescent Parenting. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ADOLESCENT PARENTING,
2 ADOLESCENT PREGNANCY PREVENTION, AND OUT-OF-WEDLOCK
3 BIRTH PROGRAMS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
7 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of one million five hundred
8 thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year. These funds shall be
9 allocated to the Division of Public Health to restore cuts in funds for teen pregnancy
10 prevention initiatives.

11 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
12 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of eight hundred twenty-five
13 thousand dollars (\$825,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to
14 restore cuts in funds for local health departments for the prevention of out-of-wedlock
15 births.

16 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Adolescent
17 Pregnancy Prevention Coalition of North Carolina the sum of one hundred thousand
18 dollars (\$100,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated as a
19 grant-in-aid.

20 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
