AN ACT TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF ARSON OR OTHER UNLAWFUL
BURNINGS THAT RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY TO A FIREFIGHTER.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. Article 15 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:
"§ 14-69.3. Arson or other unlawful burning that results in serious injury to a
firefighter.
A person is guilty of a Class E felony if the person commits an offense under Article
15 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes and a firefighter suffers serious bodily injury
while discharging or attempting to discharge the firefighter's duties as a result of the
criminal offense."
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, and applies to

offenses committed on or after that date.
