BILL SUMMARY: The bill authorizes the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue an Alpha Kappa Alpha sorority special registration plate.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: The bill does not affect the General Fund. In addition, there is no revenue impact on the Highway Fund since the special plate applicants pay the same $\$ 20$ vehicle registration fee that they were paying for a regular license plate.

According to the Division of Motor Vehicles, there is a one-time cost of approximately $\$ 100$ to design a new plate. There is also a production cost of approximately $\$ 3.00$ per plate based on one color design. The cost per plate will increase if more color is added or the design is complex. Since the number of applications for these plates is unknown, this fiscal analysis assumes only the minimum 300 applicants needed to qualify for a plate. Thus, the total production cost for 300 plates is $\$ 1,000$. Under current statutes, all special plate registrations are charged an additional \$10. Assuming 300 plates, the bill raises $\$ 3,000$ for the special plate account.
