G.S. 131E-76(1a) reads as rewritten: "§ 131E-76. Definitions. As used in this article, unless otherwise specified: (1a) "Critical access hospital" means a hospital which has been designated as a critical access hospital by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Research, Demonstrations and Rural Health Development. To be designated as a critical access hospital under this subdivision, the hospital must meet the requirements of federal law for certification as a critical access hospital-be certified as a critical access hospital pursuant to 42 CFR Part 485 Subpart F. The North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Research, Demonstrations, and Rural Health Development may designate a hospital located in a Metropolitan Statistical Area as a rural hospital is located in a county with twenty-five percent (25%) or more rural residents as defined by	Short Title: H	ospital License/Conforming Change.
