



1 section. The person who prepares a certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth shall leave  
2 blank any references to the stillborn child's name if the stillborn child's parent or parents  
3 do not wish to provide a name for the stillborn child. The certificate of birth resulting in  
4 stillbirth shall clearly indicate that it is not proof of a live birth. One copy of the  
5 certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth shall be provided at no cost to the parent  
6 requesting the certificate. Additional copies shall be subject to the same fees as a  
7 certificate of live birth. Issuance of a certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth does not  
8 replace the requirement to file a report of fetal death under this section. Access to copies  
9 of a certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth is governed by G.S. 130A-93."

10 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2005.
