A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO REPLACE THE ALLIANCE OF AMERICAN INSURERS AND 3 NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF INDEPENDENT INSURERS WITH THE PROPERTY CASUALTY INSURERS ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA AND THE 4 5 NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANIES AS TRADE ASSOCIATION MEMBERS WHICH MUST BE REPRESENTED ON 6 THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA REINSURANCE 7 8 FACILITY.

9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 58-37-35(d) reads as rewritten:

The Facility shall be administered by a Board of Governors. The Board of 11 "(d) Governors shall consist of 12 members having one vote each from the classifications 12 specified in this subsection and the Commissioner, who shall serve ex officio without 13 vote. Each Facility insurance company member serving on the Board shall be 14 represented by a senior officer of the company. Not more than one company in a group 15 under the same ownership or management shall be represented on the Board at the same 16 time. Five members of the Board shall be selected by the member insurers, which 17 members shall be fairly representative of the industry. To insure representative member 18 insurers, one each shall be selected from the following trade associations: the American 19 Insurance Association (or its successors), the Alliance of American Insurers (or its 20 21 successors), the National Association of Independent Insurers (or its successors), the National Association of Mutual Insurance Companies (or its successors), the Property 22 Casualty Insurers Association of America (or its successors), all other stock insurers not 23 affiliated with those trade associations, and all other nonstock insurers not affiliated 24 with those trade associations. The Commissioner shall appoint two members of the 25 Board who are Facility insurance company members domiciled in this State. The 26 Commissioner shall appoint five members of the Board who shall be fire and casualty 27

insurance agents licensed in this State and actively engaged in writing motor vehicle 1 2 insurance in this State. The initial term of office of the Board members shall be two 3 years. Following completion of initial terms, successors to the members of the original 4 Board of Governors shall be selected to serve three years. All members of the Board of 5 Governors shall serve until their successors are selected and qualified and the 6 Commissioner may fill any vacancy on the Board from any of the classifications specified in this subsection until the vacancies are filled in accordance with this Article. 7 The Board of Governors of the Facility shall also have as nonvoting members two 8 9 persons who are not employed by or affiliated with any insurance company or the 10 Department and who are appointed by the Governor to serve at the Governor's pleasure." 11
