HOUSE BILL 1266 RATIFIED BILL

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION WILL PAY AS RELOCATION ASSISTANCE FOR REASONABLE EXPENSES FOR SEARCHING FOR A REPLACEMENT BUSINESS OR FARM, AS REQUIRED BY FEDERAL REGULATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 133-8(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Whenever the acquisition of real property for a program or project undertaken by an agency will result in the displacement of any person, such agency shall make a payment to any displaced person, upon application as approved by the head of the agency for:

(1) Actual reasonable expenses in moving himself, his family, business,

farm operation, or other personal property;

(2) Actual direct losses of tangible personal property as a result of moving or discontinuing a business or farm operation, but not to exceed an amount equal to the reasonable expenses that would have been required to relocate such property, as determined by the relocation officer; and

(3) Actual reasonable expenses in searching for a replacement business or farm in accordance with criteria established by the lead agency, but not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000); two thousand five hundred

dollars (\$2,500); and

(4) Actual reasonable expenses necessary to reestablish a displaced farm, nonprofit organization, or small business at its new site, in accordance with criteria to be established by the lead agency, but not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000)."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 16th day of August, 2005.
