A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A JUDICIAL HEARING MAY BE CONDUCTED TO

DETERMINE THE SOURCE OF MONEY OR PROPERTY FOR A SECURED

APPEARANCE BOND AND THAT THE MONEY OR PROPERTY MAY BE

REFUSED IF IT WAS NOT DERIVED FROM A LAWFUL SOURCE OR WILL

NOT REASONABLY ASSURE APPEARANCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 26 of Chapter 15A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 15A-534.6. Source of bail.

A judicial official may, upon motion of the State or upon the judicial official's own motion, and for good cause shown, conduct a hearing into the source of money or property posted or to be posted for any defendant who has been released or is about to be released on a secured appearance bond. If the judicial official finds the money or property posted or proposed to be posted for the appearance bond is not derived from a lawful source or will not reasonably assure the appearance of the person required, the judicial official may refuse to accept the offered money or property as security for the appearance bond."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2005, and applies to bond hearings conducted on or after that date, provided that if a pretrial release order has been entered prior to the effective date of this act, the court may not revoke or modify the order of release solely on the basis of this act.
