LICENSE PURCHASED PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 2005, IS EXEMPT FROM
SALTWATER FISHING LICENSE REQUIREMENTS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 113-174.2(d) reads as rewritten:
"(d) Exemptions. – An individual may engage in recreational fishing by means of
recreational gear without having purchased a SFL if the individual either:
(1) the individual is <u>Is</u> 18 years of age or younger and is currently enrolled
in school and is making progress toward obtaining a high school
diploma or its equivalent.
(2) Holds a Lifetime Resident Comprehensive Fishing License under
G.S. 113-271(d)(3) or a Lifetime Sportsman License under
G.S. 113-270.1D(b) purchased prior to January 1, 2005."
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective January 1, 2006.
