| 7  | <b>SECTION 1.</b> Notwithstanding the time limitations contained in G.S. 135-5.3         |
| 8  | and G.S. 135-40.3A, the boards of directors of Success Institute, a charter school in    |
| 9  | Statesville, and Piedmont Community Charter School in Gastonia may elect to become       |
| 10 | participating employers in the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System in       |
| 11 | accordance with Article 1 of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes and may also elect to   |
| 12 | become participating employing units in the North Carolina Teachers' and State           |
| 13 | Employees' Comprehensive Major Medical Plan in accordance with Article 3 of              |
| 14 | Chapter 135. The elections authorized by this section shall be made no later than 30     |
| 15 | days after the effective date of this act and shall be made in accordance with all other |
| 16 | requirements of G.S. 135-5.3 and G.S. 135-40.3A.   |
| 17 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.                             |
