2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE TEACCH PROGRAM AT THE
3	UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
6	Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of four hundred forty-eight
7	thousand three hundred forty-nine dollars (\$448,349) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year.
8	These funds shall be allocated to the TEACCH Program in the Department of
9	Psychiatry at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, as follows:
10	(1) \$283,349 to increase the psychoeducatioal therapists' salaries and for
11	additional fringe benefits.
12	(2) \$145,000 for TEACCH clinic rents and operations.
13	(3) \$20,000 for the TEACCH DX and Medical Consultation Clinic.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
