A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THREE
NEW MAGISTRATE POSITIONS FOR CUMBERLAND COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Each county shall have the numbers of magistrates and additional seats of district court, as set forth in the following table:

12 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated the sum of one hundred twenty-eight
13 thousand six hundred one dollars (\$128,601) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum
14 of one hundred fifteen thousand one hundred sixty-seven dollars (\$115,167) for the
15 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish three new magistrate positions for Cumberland
16 County.

17 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
