6	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-51 reads as rewritten:	
7	"§ 20-51. Exempt from registration.	
8	The following shall be exempt from the requirement of registration and certificate of	
9	title:

11	<u>(5</u>	a) Fertilizer spreader vehicles, including those operated on a for-hire
12		basis, when used by a farmer, his tenant, agent, or employee in
13		transporting fertilizer from place to place on the same farm, or from
14		one farm to another. This exemption shall extend also to fertilizer
15		spreader vehicles while on any trip within a radius of 10 miles from
16		the point of loading, provided that the vehicle does not exceed a speed
17		of 35 miles per hour.
