HOUSE BILL 2526 RATIFIED BILL

AN ACT TO EXEMPT CLAY COUNTY FROM CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC CONTRACTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 143-128, 143-129, and 143-132, Clay County may use the design-build method of construction for an indoor recreational facility that will be located at 365 Anderson Street, Hayesville, North Carolina, a sheriff's office building, and a county administration building. Notwithstanding any provision of law, Clay County may award each contract in its sole discretion. SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 10th day of July, 2006.
