A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTY IN BRUNSWICK COUNTY FOR THE  
ILLEGAL SALE OF DRUGS IF THE TRANSACTION OCCURS IN OR NEAR A  
PUBLIC PARK.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 90-95(e) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:  
"(11) Any person 21 years of age or older who commits an offense under  
G.S. 90-95(a)(1) on property that is a public park or within 300 feet of  
the boundary of real property that is a public park shall be punished as  
a Class E felon. For purposes of this subdivision, the transfer of less  
than five grams of marijuana for no remuneration shall not constitute a  
delivery in violation of G.S. 90-95(a)(1)."

**SECTION 2.** This act applies only to Brunswick County.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2006, and applies to  
offenses committed on or after that date.
