2 AN ACT TO PROTECT THE IDENTITY OF INDIVIDUALS BY AUTHORIZING
3 THE TAKING OF FINGERPRINTS AND PHOTOGRAPHS FOR MOTOR
4 VEHICLE VIOLATIONS OF FAILING TO PRODUCE A LICENSE OR
5 LEARNER'S PERMIT TO ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
6 REQUESTING IT FOR LAWFUL PURPOSES PURSUANT TO G.S. 20-29, AND
7 VIOLATIONS OF THE DRIVERS LICENSE AND LEARNER'S PERMIT
8 PROVISIONS IN G.S. 20-30.

9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

10 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 15A-502(b) reads as rewritten:

11 "(b) This section does not authorize the taking of photographs or fingerprints
12 when the offense charged is a Class 2 or 3 misdemeanor under Chapter 20 of the
13 General Statutes, "~~Motor Vehicles.~~"Vehicles," except for violations of G.S. 20-29 or
14 any of the provisions of G.S. 20-30."

15 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2006, and applies to
16 offenses committed on or after that date.
