AN ACT REQUIRING COMPANY POLICE AGENCIES TO NOTIFY THE CITY OF
WINSTON-SALEM POLICE DEPARTMENT WHEN THEY ARE PROVIDING
ON-SITE POLICE SECURITY PERSONNEL SERVICES WITHIN THE
DEPARTMENT'S JURISDICTION AND TO PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT
WITH CERTAIN INFORMATION ON ARRESTS MADE BY THE AGENCIES.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. G.S. 74E-13 is amended by adding the following new
subsection to read:
"(d) Prior to the provision of services, a company police agency certified under
this Chapter shall notify the Winston-Salem Police Department that it is providing
on-site police security personnel services for persons or property within the Police
Department's territorial jurisdiction. The notification shall be in writing and shall
include the names of the companies or individuals receiving services, the physical
locations where services will be provided, and the beginning and ending dates for the
contracts for each location. Within 48 hours of any arrest made by a company police officer within the
Within 48 hours of any arrest made by a company police officer within the Winston-Salem Police Department's territorial jurisdiction, the agency shall provide to
the Police Department the following information:
(1) The name and address of the individual arrested;
(2) The offense for which the individual was arrested; and
(3) The date and location of the offense.
As used in this act, the term 'territorial jurisdiction' includes the Winston-Salem
Police Department's jurisdiction as defined in G.S. 160A-286."
SECTION 2. This act applies only to the City of Winston-Salem and
company police agencies providing on-site police security personnel services for

persons or property within the territorial jurisdiction of the Winston-Salem Police

Department.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005. It applies to all contracts for services existing on or commencing after the effective date and to arrests made on or after the effective date.
