A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CARRBORO TO LEVY A MOTOR
VEHICLE TAX NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-97(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) General Municipal Vehicle Tax. – Cities and towns may levy a tax of not more than ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per year upon any vehicle resident in the city or town. The proceeds of the tax may be used for any lawful purpose."

SECTION 2. Section 3 of Chapter 392 of the 1991 Session Laws, as amended by Section 5.1 of Chapter 339 of the 1995 Session Laws, is repealed effective upon the date the Town of Carrboro acts to levy an additional tax under this act.

SECTION 3. This act applies to the Town of Carrboro only.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
