A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO LIMIT THE HEIGHT OF STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF KURE  
BEACH.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** No building erected within the corporate limits of the Town of Kure Beach may have a height in excess of 35 feet above ground level unless the building was erected before the effective date of this act. The Town Council shall not grant a variance of the height limitation.

**SECTION 2.** The height limitation created by Section 1 of this act does not apply to spires, belfries, cupolas, antennas, water tanks, ventilators, chimneys, or other appurtenances usually required to be placed above the roof level and not intended for human occupancy.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
