14	(1)	The address of the board, and the names of its members and
15		officers; officers.
16	(2)	The number of persons who applied to the board for
17		examination; examination.
18	(3)	The number who were refused examination; examination.
19	(4)	The number who took the examination; examination.
20	(5)	The number to whom initial licenses were issued; issued.
21	(6)	The number who applied for license by reciprocity or comity; comity.
22	(7)	The number who were granted licenses by reciprocity or
23		<del>comity;<u>comity.</u></del>
24	(8)	The number of licenses suspended or revoked; and revoked.
25	(9)	The number of licenses terminated for any reason other than failure to
26		pay the required renewal fee.

2		board to the General Assembly to amend statutes related to the

4	<u>(11)</u>	The substance of any anticipated change in rules adopted by the

6		adoption of new rules by the occupational licensing board.
7	<u>(b)</u> Eac	h occupational licensing board shall file with the Secretary of State, the
8	Attorney Ger	eral, and the Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight
9	Committee a f	inancial report that includes the source and amount of all funds credited to
10	the occupation	al licensing board and the purpose and amount of all funds disbursed by
11	the occupation	al licensing board during the previous 12-month period.
12	<u>(c)</u> The	reports required by this section shall be open to public inspection."
13	SEC	CTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006. The first reports
14	required by G	S. 93B-2, as amended by Section 1 of this act, are due no later than July
15	1, 2007.
