| 11 | with the Attorney General an annual financial report, and State, the Attorney General, |
| 12 | and the Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee an annual |
| 13 | report containing <u>all of the following information</u> : |
| 14 | (1) The address of the board, and the names of its members and |
| 15 | officers; officers. |
| 16 | (2) The number of persons who applied to the board for |
| 17 | examination;examination. |
| 18 | (3) The number who were refused examination; examination. |
| 19 | (4) The number who took the examination; examination. |
| 20 | (5) The number to whom initial licenses were issued; issued. |
| 21 | (6) The number who applied for license by reciprocity or comity;comity. |
| 22 | (7) The number who were granted licenses by reciprocity or |
| 23 | comity; <u>comity.</u> |
| 24 | (8) The number of licenses suspended or revoked; and <u>revoked</u>. |
| 25 | (9) The number of licenses terminated for any reason other than failure to |
| 26 | pay the required renewal fee. |
