2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
3 ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO COVER INCREASED
4 PROGRAM OPERATING COSTS AND THE COSTS OF ANY LEGISLATIVE
5 SALARY INCREASE FOR PERSONNEL WHO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM,
6 AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.(a)** There is appropriated from the Commercial Leaking
9 Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund to the Department of Environment
10 and Natural Resources up to one hundred thirty-seven thousand one hundred and six
11 dollars (\$137,106) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year as needed to cover increased program
12 operating costs and the cost of any legislative salary increase for personnel who
13 administer the underground storage tank program under Parts 2A and 2B of Article 21A
14 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes.

15 **SECTION 1.(b)** There is appropriated from the Noncommercial Leaking
16 Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund to the Department of Environment
17 and Natural Resources up to one hundred thirty-seven thousand one hundred and six
18 dollars (\$137,106) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year as needed to cover increased program
19 operating costs and the cost of any legislative salary increase for personnel who
20 administer the underground storage tank program under Parts 2A and 2B of Article 21A
21 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes.

22 **SECTION 1.(c)** It is the intent of the General Assembly that funds
23 appropriated under this section are recurring funds and that these funds are in addition
24 to funds appropriated under subsections (b) and (d) of Section 11.4 of S. L. 2003-284
25 and subsection (b) of Section 30.10 of S.L. 2004-124.

26 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective 1 July 2006.
