Short Title: Certain Towns to Regulate Golf Carts. (Local)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWNS OF ROSE HILL AND BLADENBORO TO
REGULATE GOLF CARTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and G.S. 20-54,
a town may, by ordinance, regulate the operation of electric golf carts on any public
street or road within the town.

By ordinance, a town may require the registration of golf carts, charge a fee
for the registration, specify the persons authorized to operate golf carts, and specify the
required equipment, load limits, and the hours and methods of operation of golf carts.

SECTION 2. This act applies only to the Towns of Rose Hill and
Bladenboro.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
