The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Section 33(c) of the Charter of the City of Rale Chapter 1184 of the 1949 Session Laws, as amended by S.L. 1991-312, S.L. and S.L. 1995-323, reads as rewritten:	
"(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section herein shall be construed as preventing any official or employee covered by from purchasing a utility service offered to the general public at uniform rangemented at a wastewater treatment plant, farm products grown on City City-leased farms, and mulch produced at the City's yard waste processing addition to the transactions authorized in this section, the City may see personal uniforms and equipment, excluding weapons, to public safety employment their separation from the City's employment.
