SECTION 1. The State Board of Education shall identify research-based		
methods to reduce the dropout rate and the number of suspended students, especially in		
high-povert	y schools with diverse student populations. As part of its st	tudy, the State
Board shall	I review the research for best practices, effective policie	es, and model
programs in	n areas such as (i) academic rigor in the curriculum, (ii) early	/ identification
of at-risk st	tudents, (iii) effective supplemental services for at-risk studen	nts, (iv) school
size, (v) so	chool climate, and (vi) adolescent literacy programs, as the	ey relate to a
reduction in	the dropout rate and the number of suspended students.	
T	The State Board shall report its findings to the Joint Legislat	tive Education
Oversight C	Committee by January 2006.
