The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. Chapter 115D of the General Statutes is amended by adding
new section to read:
"§ 115D-7.1. Establishment of the Customized Industry Training Program.
(a) There is created within the North Carolina Community College System t
Customized Industry Training (CIT) Program. The CIT Program shall offer program
and training services as new options for assisting existing business and industry
remain productive, profitable, and within the State. Before a business or industrial
qualifies to receive assistance under the CIT Program, the President of the Nor
Carolina Community College System shall determine that:
(1) The business is making an appreciable capital investment;
(2) The business is deploying new technology;
(3) The skills of the workers will be enhanced by the assistance.
(b) The State Board shall report on an annual basis to the Joint Legislati
Education Oversight Committee on:
(1) The total amount of funds received by a company under the C
Program;
(2) The amount of funds per trainee received by that company;
(3) The amount of funds received per trainee by the community colle
delivering the training;
(4) The number of trainees trained by the company and commun
college; and
(5) The number of years that company has been funded.
(c) The State Board shall adopt rules and policies to implement this section."
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
