BILL SUMMARY:

This bill allows the Town of West Jefferson to levy a 3% occupancy tax. The bill requires the proceeds to go to the West Jefferson Tourism Development Authority. At least two-thirds of the funds are to be used to promote travel and tourism in West Jefferson and the remainder is to be used for travel-related expenditures.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

There is currently one hotel in the city limits of West Jefferson. Based on hotel receipts, the town estimates that the occupancy tax will generate between \$15,000 and \$20,000 annually. For the purposes of this analysis, an estimate of \$17,500 is used for the first year. An annual rate of increase of 4% is used to project revenues for future years.
