SESSION LAW 2007-89 HOUSE BILL 1141

AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE QUARRY TO ALLOW THE TOWN TO OPERATE UNDER THE COUNCIL-MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 5-1 of the Charter of the Town of Granite Quarry, being S.L. 2003-203, reads as rewritten:

"Section 5-1. **Town to Operate Under <u>Mayor-Council</u> <u>Council-Manager</u> Plan. The Town of Granite Quarry <u>operates</u> <u>shall</u> <u>operate</u> <u>under</u> the <u>mayor councilcouncil-manager</u> plan as provided in <u>Part 3Part 2</u> of Article 7 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes."**

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 18th day of June, 2007.
