**HOUSE BILL 1182  
RATIFIED BILL**

AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE VILLAGE OF SUGAR MOUNTAIN TO EXTEND THE MAYOR'S TERM OF OFFICE FROM TWO YEARS TO FOUR YEARS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 3.4 of the Charter of the Village of Sugar Mountain, being Chapter 395 of the 1985 Session Laws, as amended by S.L. 2000-63, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3.4. Election of Mayor; term of office. Until a Mayor is elected in accordance with this section, Marjorie Unrath shall serve as Mayor. In ~~1985-2007~~ and ~~biennially~~ quadrennially thereafter, a Mayor shall be elected for a ~~two-year~~ four-year term."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2007.
