7	The General Assembly	of North Carolina enacts:		
8		G.S. 18B-101 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:		
9	" <u>(14c)</u> <u>"Scen</u>	ic byways bed and breakfast inns" means a business of not more		
10	than	12 guest rooms that offers lodging accommodations for at least		
11	nine 1	out not more than 23 persons and that meets all of the following		
12	<u>condi</u>	tions:		
13	<u>a.</u>	It is located in a county with three or more designated scenic		
14		byways as designated by the North Carolina Department of		
15		<u>Transportation.</u>		
16	<u>b.</u>	It operates a kitchen utilizing commercial restaurant equipment		
17		and meets the food and beverage requirements of a restaurant as		
18		defined in G.S. 18B-1000(6). The dining area shall feature a		
19		seating capacity of 23 or more persons for the purpose of		
20		serving food and beverage to guests of the inn and to the		
21		general public for pay.		
22	<u>c.</u>	It caters on-site private parties and receptions.		
23	<u>d.</u>	It is located in a county in which the on-premises sale of malt		
24		beverages and unfortified wine is authorized in at least two		
25		municipalities.		
26	<u>e.</u>	It is located in a county where 100 or more businesses have		
27		active alcoholic beverage permits issued by the North Carolina		
28		Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission.		

1		f. It is located in a county in which the on-premises sale of malt
2		beverages and unfortified wine is authorized for a competitive
3		bed and breakfast inn or restaurant within a three-mile radius.
4		g. It is the permanent residence of the owner or the manager of the
5		business.
6		A scenic byways bed and breakfast inn shall maintain an Internet Web
7		site to attract travelers and tourists and shall advertise at least quarterly
8		in a state or regional publication or in the State travel guide published
9		by the North Carolina Department of Commerce."
10		SECTION 2. G.S. 18B-603(f) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
11	read:	
12		"(10) The permits authorized by G.S. 18B-1001(1), (3), (5), and (10) for
13		scenic byways bed and breakfast inns."
14		SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
