1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE PROCESS BY WHICH BOARDS OF COUNTY 3 COMMISSIONERS MAY APPOINT MEMBERS TO A MULTICOUNTY AREA 4 AUTHORITY BOARD. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 SECTION 1. G.S. 122C-118.1 reads as rewritten: 7 "§ 122C-118.1. Structure of area board. 8 An area board shall have no fewer than 11 and no more than 25 members. (a) However, the area board for a multicounty area authority consisting of eight or more 9 counties and serving a catchment area with a population of more than 500,000 may have 10 up to 30 members. In a single-county area authority, the members shall be appointed by 11 12 the board of county commissioners. Except as otherwise provided, provided in subsection (a1) of this section, in areas consisting of more than one county, each board 13 14 of county commissioners within the area shall appoint one commissioner as a member of the area board. These members shall appoint the other members. The boards of 15 county commissioners within the multicounty area shall have the option to appoint the 16 17 members of the area board in a manner other than as required under this section by adopting a resolution to that effect. The boards of county commissioners in a 18 multicounty area authority shall indicate in the business plan each board's method of 19 20 appointment of the area board members in accordance with G.S. 122C-115.2(b). These appointments shall take into account sufficient citizen participation, representation of 21 22 the disability groups, and equitable representation of participating counties. Individuals 23 appointed to the board shall include two individuals with financial expertise, an individual with expertise in management or business, and an individual representing the 24 25 interests of children. A member of the board may be removed with or without cause by 26 the initial appointing authority. Vacancies on the board shall be filled by the initial 27 appointing authority before the end of the term of the vacated seat or within 90 days of

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1	the vacancy, whichever occurs first, and the appointments shall be for the remainder of
2	the unexpired term.
3	(a1) The boards of county commissioners within a multicounty area authority may
4	appoint the members of the area board in a manner other than is required under this
5	section if each board of county commissioners adopts a resolution specifying how the
6	area board will be appointed. Pursuant to G.S. 122C-115.2(b), the boards of county
7	commissioners in a multicounty area authority shall also indicate in the local business
8	plan each board's method of appointment of the area board members. The appointments
9	shall take into account sufficient citizen participation, representation of the disability
10	groups, and equitable representation of participating counties. The term limitations in
11	subsection (d) of this section shall not apply to appointments made according to
12	resolutions adopted under this subsection and included in an area authority's local
13	business plan.
14	(b) Not more than fifty percent (50%) of the members of the area board shall
15	represent the following:
16	(1) A physician licensed under Chapter 90 of the General Statutes to
17	practice medicine in North Carolina who, when possible, is certified as
18	having completed a residency in psychiatry.
19	(2) A clinical professional from the fields of mental health, developmental
20	disabilities, or substance abuse.
21	(3) At least one family member or individual from a citizens' organization
22	composed primarily of consumers or their family members,
23	representing the interests of individuals:
24	a. With mental illness;
25 26	b. In recovery from addiction; or
26 27	c. With developmental disabilities.
27 28	(4) At least one openly declared consumer:a. With mental illness;
28 29	a. With mental illness;b. With developmental disabilities; or

31	(c) The board of county commissioners may elect to appoint a member of the
32	area authority board to fill concurrently no more than two categories of membership if
33	the member has the qualifications or attributes of the two categories of membership.
33 34	(d) Any member of an area board who is a county commissioner serves on the
35	board in an ex officio capacity. The terms of county commissioners on an area board are
36	concurrent with their terms as county commissioners. The terms of the other members
37	on the area board shall be for three years, except that upon the initial formation of an
38	area board one-third shall be appointed for one year, one-third for two years, and all
39	remaining members for three years. <u>Members-Except as provided in subsection (a1) of</u>
40	this section, members shall not be appointed for more than two consecutive terms.
41	Board members serving as of July 1, 2006, may remain on the board for one additional
42	term.
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1 (e) Upon request, the board shall provide information pertaining to the 2 membership of the board that is a public record under Chapter 132 of the General 3 Statutes."

4 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. A multicounty area 5 authority may amend its local business plan to reflect appointments made pursuant to 6 this act.
