The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 24 of Chapter 7B of the General Statutes is	amended
by adding a new section to read:	
"§ 7B-2402.1. Restraint of juveniles in courtroom.	
At any hearing authorized or required by this Subchapter, the judge may	subject a
juvenile to physical restraint in the courtroom only when the judge finds the re	straint to
be reasonably necessary to maintain order, prevent the juvenile's escape, or pre-	ovide for
the safety of the courtroom. The judge shall provide the juvenile and the j	uvenile's
attorney an opportunity to be heard to contest the use of restraints before t	he judge
orders the use of restraints. If restraints are ordered, the judge shall make fir	idings of
fact in support of the order."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2007, and appl	ies to all
hearings conducted on or after that date.
