be reasonable	ly necessary to maintain order, prevent the juvenile's escape, or pro	vide for
the safety of	the courtroom. Whenever practical, the judge shall provide the juve	enile and
the juvenile'	s attorney an opportunity to be heard to contest the use of restraint	is before
the judge or	rders the use of restraints. If restraints are ordered, the judge sha	<u>all make</u>
findings of f	act in support of the order."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2007, and applies to all		
hearings con	ducted on or after that date.
