A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EDGECOMBE/NASH CENTER FOR FAMILY GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Edgecombe/Nash Center for Family Growth and Development Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of three hundred fifty-four thousand dollars (\$354,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$60,000 to the Edgecombe Nash Center for Family Growth and Development to provide support and funding for innovative programming for residents and clients, education training and professional development opportunities for affected citizens and staff, research activities, and state-of-the-art knowledge and activities to attract students and workers into health and social services occupations.
- (2) \$80,000 for Single Women in Mission, a nonprofit organization, to support single women and children through its mentoring and domestic violence prevention program.
- (3) \$100,000 for The Wright's Center, a nonprofit organization providing day health care services to disabled adults.
- (4) \$114,000 for Crosswork, Inc., a nonprofit organization providing services to combat chronic diseases and to assist persons living with diabetes.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
