7 **PART I. INTRODUCTION AND TITLE OF ACT**

9 **INTRODUCTION**

10           **SECTION 1.1.** The appropriations made in this act are for maximum  
11 amounts necessary to provide the services and accomplish the purposes described in the  
12 budget. Savings shall be effected where the total amounts appropriated are not required  
13 to perform these services and accomplish these purposes, and savings shall revert to the  
14 appropriate fund at the end of each fiscal year as allowed by the State Budget Act unless  
15 otherwise provided by this act or other law.

17 **TITLE OF ACT**

18           **SECTION 1.2.** This act shall be known as the "Current Operations and  
19 Capital Improvements Appropriations Act of 2007."

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23 **CURRENT OPERATIONS AND EXPANSION/GENERAL FUND**

24           **SECTION 2.** Appropriations from the General Fund of the State for the  
25 maintenance of the State departments, institutions, and agencies, and for other purposes

1 as enumerated, are made for the biennium ending June 30, 2009, in accordance with the  
2 provisions of this act.

7 **SECTION 3.** Appropriations from the State Highway Fund for the  
8 maintenance and operation of the Department of Transportation and for other purposes  
9 as enumerated are made for the biennium ending June 30, 2009, in accordance with the  
10 provisions of this act.

15 **SECTION 4.** Appropriations from the State Highway Trust Fund for the  
16 maintenance and operation of the Department of Transportation and for other purposes  
17 as enumerated are made for the biennium ending June 30, 2009, in accordance with the  
18 provisions of this act.

23 **SECTION 5.1.** Appropriations from federal block grant funds are made for  
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, in accordance with the provisions of this act.

27 **SECTION 5.2.** Appropriations from federal block grant funds are made for  
28 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, in accordance with the provisions of this act.

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30 **PART VI. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

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32 **STATE BUDGET ACT APPLIES**

33 **SECTION 6.1.** The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the  
34 General Statutes, are reenacted and shall remain in full force and effect and are  
35 incorporated in this act by reference.

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37 **MOST TEXT APPLIES ONLY TO THE 2007-2009 FISCAL BIENNIUM**

38 **SECTION 6.2.** Except for statutory changes or other provisions that clearly  
39 indicate an intention to have effects beyond the 2007-2009 fiscal biennium, the textual  
40 provisions of this act apply only to funds appropriated for, and activities occurring  
41 during, the 2007-2009 fiscal biennium.

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43 **EFFECT OF HEADINGS**

1           **SECTION 6.3.** The headings to the parts and sections of this act are a  
2 convenience to the reader and are for reference only. The headings do not expand,  
3 limit, or define the text of this act, except for effective dates referring to a part.  
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5 **SEVERABILITY CLAUSE**

6           **SECTION 6.4.** If any section or provision of this act is declared  
7 unconstitutional or invalid by the courts, it does not affect the validity of this act as a  
8 whole or any part other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.  
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10 **EFFECTIVE DATE**

11           **SECTION 6.5.** Except as otherwise provided, this act becomes effective  
12 July 1, 2007.
